

Sanctioned Bar Tournament Rules for the Missouri All-Star Challenge Series

1. Any Play-Mor Coin-Op served location may host sanctioned dart tournaments in conjunction with the Missouri All Star Challenge Series.
2. Each bar that participates in any Play-Mor Dart League may host one (1) dart tournament per night of league play. If there is a split division that the league office approves, this will count for two nights of play. Play-Mor League All Star and Rising Star players will earn bonus points for attending any sanctioned bar tournament.
3. The game format, added money or not, rate of entry fee and all features not specifically mentioned below are subject to the bars discretion. The sanctioning requirements of the bar are as follows:
 - All sanctioned tournaments are open to all players in the league as well as any other players from the public.
 - All sanctioned tournaments are coordinated with the Play-Mor League office so they are posted in league newsletters and on the Play-Mor Coin-Op web site to ensure good attendance.
 - All sanctioned tournaments are to be held on weekends. Friday, Saturday or Sunday.
 - All sanctioned tournaments must have at least five current league All Stars in attendance to ensure adequate competition.
 - All sanctioned tournaments must utilize and return the official registration documents and bracket sheets to the league office within 10 days of an event; as provided in the sanctioned bar tournament packet.
 - Play-Mor Dart League personnel may attend and provide information to any potential new league players during the event.
 - Drawing for partners where there are female players involved and where there are less females than males, it is **recommended** that it will be done in a manner that will ensure all female players draw a male partner. To achieve that goal, all females will draw their partners first. Before the drawing of partners, the manner of which the draw will be conducted should be announced by the person in charge of running the sanctioned tournament.

4. Existing All Star / Rising Star players can earn a total of 50 points just for participating in these sanctioned tournaments, and up to 60 points when combined with bonus points for “wins” and **Female All Stars** who are the highest in the finishing order as follows:

- Five (5) points are available to every All-Star / Rising Star for simply participating in a sanctioned bar tournament. 50 points maximum for attending 10 or more sanctioned bar tournaments.
- Two (2) additional points are available for winning any sanctioned bar tournament or for the highest finishing female All Star player*. The additional two (2) points for a “win” or highest finishing female All Star* is limited to just five times per player.
- This combination of available points to earn, equates to 60 points maximum for attending 10 or more sanctioned bar tournaments and earning the two (2) bonus points for “wins” or being the highest finishing female* at least 5 times.

*Note: Should two or more female All Star players tie for the highest finishing position at a Sanctioned Bar Tournament, they must immediately break the tie by playing separate games of Count-Up and note the outcome on the bracket sheet which must be returned to the league office.

5. Once the Play-Mor Dart League office receives the tournament documents back from the bar, All Star / Rising Star player points are posted on the Play-Mor Coin-Op web site and added to the tally for each player. Note: All Star / Rising Star point tallies are frozen two weeks prior to the third (3rd) All Star Tournament so all sanctioned tournaments are to be scheduled prior to that date and all documents must be immediately returned to league office prior to that deadline.
